


Environmental Policy

We recognize that our activities have an impact on the environment in the use of raw materials, emissions to air and water, waste generation, and interaction with marine life and habitat. We are committed to minimizing this impact as far as is reasonably practicable for both offshore and land-based activities. We do this by maintaining a program of continual improvement in environmental performance incorporating suitable measurement and monitoring.

We are committed to:

1. Comply with environmental legislation, regulations, and codes of practice relevant to the industry sector in which we operate.
2. Reduce the consumption of natural resources and materials by improving efficiency, including the use of water, energy, fuel, and raw materials.
3. Minimize the impact of our operations on the environments in which we operate, including habitat, wildlife, fauna, and flora.
4. Reduce emissions by selection of fuel, technology, operating efficiency and optimizing business travel.
5. Prevent pollution through release to the environment and have in place emergency plans to minimize the impact should a release occur.
6. Promote recycling and wherever possible use materials that have been recycled or can be recycled after use.
7. Actively pursue the sourcing and use of more environmentally friendly products.
8. Minimize and segregate waste, ensuring the safe keeping, transportation and subsequent recovery or disposal.
9. Include environmental issues in our training programs to enable employees to fulfil their responsibilities and encourage staff to contribute to sound environmental practice.
10. Encourage major suppliers and contractors to develop similar environmental policies and programs.
